**08:15** Laying down wreath at Oddernes Kirke [church].

**08:45** Norwegian tones will be played from the fire tower on the square.

**08:50** Market Square: The school parade lines up.

**09:00** Welcome speech by the Head of the 17 May committee, Vidar Lynnæs. All the school band plays, and everyone sings one verse of the national anthem of Norway, "Ja, vi

elsker". Speech of the day, by Josefine Damman, Fagerholt Skole. Rabakoret sings. Adrian Nikqi, Krossen skole will lay down flowers on the King's statue. Award ceremony by one of the members of the adolescence board, for the pupils' drawing contest. We end with everyone singing one verse of "Kongesangen"; a common number with the choir and all the bands. Kristiansand school band plays to the marching out of the parade.

**12:15** At the stairway to Handelens Hus: Concert with Kristiansand Handelsstands Sangforening. Conductor: Lasse Stray.

**12:20** Preschool parade, for children under school age together with adults. Line up in Gyldenløves gate.

**12:30** Kristiansand Cathedral: Organ concert, performed by cantor Elsebeth Lucherath. Free entrance.

**12:45** Wergelandsparken: Laying down wreath at the Jørgen Løvland statue.

**13:00** Christiansholm Fortress: Singsong with Kristiansands Haandverker Sangforening. Conductor: Jan Helge Skaar.

**13:00** Laying down wreaths at Arkivet [Vesterveien 4].

**13:00** Laying down wreath at the 22 July monument.

**13:15** Ravnedalen: Concert at Café Generalen. Kristiansand Janitsjar. Conductor: Rune Hansen

**13:30** Wergelandsparken: Speech for Henrik Wergeland.

**14:00** Ravnedalen: Laying down wreath at General Oscar Wergeland statue.

**14:00** Kilden Performing Arts Centre: Gala concert with Kristiansand Symphony Orchestra.

**14:00** Mini concert at the fishing pier by "Blæsen"

**14:00** Market Square: Interdenominational song session by "Sammen for byen". Ansgar Gospel Choir.

**14:30** Tresse: Laying down wreath at the Veteranmonument.

**15:00** Market Square: Drill performance by Tveit Union Musikkorps.

**15:45** The civic parade lines up at the Market Square.

**16:00** Welcome speech by the Head of the 17 May committee, Vidar Lynnæs. Everyone sings one verse of the national anthem of Norway, "Ja, vi elsker". Speech of the day by Mayor Harald Furre. Kristiansands Haandverker Sangforening participates. We end with everybody sings one verse of "Gud signe vårt dyre fedreland". All the bands plays. The vehicles must continue straight ahead along Kongens gate when the parade is finished!

**18:00** Gala concert in Kristiansand Cathedral. Bjørn Andor Drage will play the organ and Kristiansand Domkor will perform national songs. Tickets at the entrance, NOK 200. Students, NOK 100. Children free entrance.

**22:30** Tapto parade. From the top of Markens gate: Tveit Union Musikkorps. From Fylkeshuset in Tordenskjolds gate: Ynglingeforeningens Musikkorps. Fireworks will be launched when the Tapto parade has arrived Tresse, at around 22:50.

**23:00** Tresse: Constitution Day ends with a big fire work and happy jazz tones performed by Rabbersvigen Jazzforsamling.
